

## Coaching accreditation Up-date Requirements List:

### Attend 6 hours coach education per year:

- attend **two (2)** per year:
  - State Coaching Centre update course (*this may be presented solely for state body, specific topics for karate coaches or generic by state coaching centre*) **or** tertiary institute coaching workshop or seminar, **or**
  - attend individual module of Level 2 General Principles course (*eg visualisation can be in house, correspondence or on-line training*) **or**
  - work related courses may be acceptable on application only (*eg conflict resolution, communication in the workplace, risk management but apply for approval first*) **or**
  - attend **one only per year** regional or state workshop/seminar on AKF Inc (National) Coaching for Competition Rules **one per year - can not claim for 2 in one year – for coaches of competition**.  
**(NOT Referees Seminars/workshops that is for NOAS)**

### OR

- attend another Level 1 course
- attain Level 2 General Principles
- upgrade to Level 2 (via Karate Specific course)

### PLUS

- ‘Plays by the Rules - Harassment Free Sport for Coaches’  
On-line course, provide copy of your certificate and results.



### If the above is not attained:

- Attend another Level 1 course **or**
- Upgrade to Level 2

### Compulsory Attainment:

- Maintain current certificate in recognised first aid course
- Current Suitability (Blue) Card – Child Protection Legislation. Police check applies if visiting NSW, Victoria, WA as of 1-1-06, and soon in SA if coaching or involvement where children are present.

### PLUS

## ALL COACHES MUST BE ACTIVELY COACHING-----

### Minimum Practical Coaching Time:

Must be actively coaching with an annual minimum of

- **Level 1** ..... 25 hours
- **Level 2** ..... 50 hours

**Coaching hours may be achieved by:**

- Dojo coaching, camps etc
- AKF national or state coach
- lecturing at AKF Inc approved coaching or referees courses
- mentoring NCAS trainee coach

*and supply details on club letter head*

**Failure to meet these requirements will mean the coach must resit the next available AKF Coaching Training Program**
